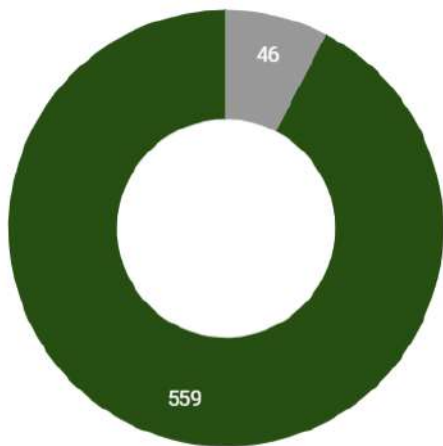
"This is such an amazing thing. I can't wait to go and volunteer at someone else's house and help rebuild their life and home."

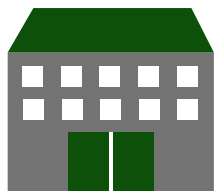

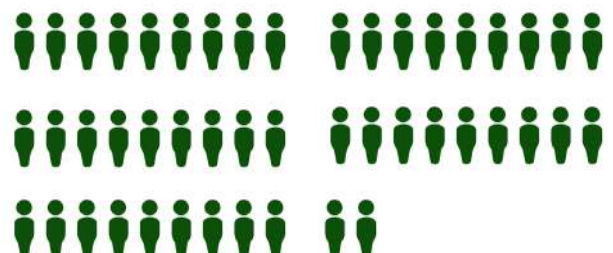
